March Demonstrator – Marcus Juniel



Marcus has been involved in bonsai since the 1990's. He has studied with Harry Hirao, Ted Matson, David Nguy, Roy Nagatoshi, and Jung Soo Kim from Korea. Marcus is known for his work on conifers including California junipers, Shimpaku junipers, Japanese black pine, and Prostrata junipers. Marcus uses his discerning eye to find material with great potential, and he works them into very special trees that express the spirit of the tree. Marcus was one of the demonstrators at the Bonsai-A-Thon this year. He will be working on a juniper at this meeting.

February Demonstrator – Maliea Chiem

Maliea Chiem brought her own brand of bonsai enthusiasm to our February meeting. It was great to have someone that was so expressive and clearly enjoys doing bonsai.

Maliea worked on a nursery stock 5 gallon can Prostate juniper, see right photo.











You can see from the series of photos above that the first step was to clean up the foliage on the lower branches, and then to decide which branches to keep. She keeps the branches long because it gives more options later, i.e., pull in to compact the branch or to change direction.











Removing several branches revealed the existing curves of the trunk so the style of the tree is almost Bunjin- like especially after the branches were wired down. Style is important but not necessary what feels right in a subtle way. Movement of branches mirrors movement of the trunk that enhances the existing beauty of the tree.



Last, Maliea jined the top after cutting off a branch she was going to keep and finished wiring the rest of the branches. And right, the winner of the raffle was new member Cedric Navarro
