From the GSBF Web Team

The Golden State Bonsai Federation has posted a new item, 'Tale of Two California Gems'

The two trees featured in this article were both collected in California, but from opposite ends of the State. The Sierra Juniper, from the northern end at around 6800 feet, and the California Juniper from the southern end in the desert. These are two very different trees, but both have endured many years of torture in the wild. At around 400 years old, the Sierra Juniper has spent its life growing in harsh winter conditions where it was beaten down by wind and snow. The California Juniper at around 300 years old has endured years of sand blast storms and harsh summer heat.

I will begin with the California Juniper. I collected this tree in 1995 at the age of 16, a few months after getting my driver's license. Unfortunately, I have no early photos of the tree, but I assure you it looked very different than it does today. Much of the shari on the trunk is natural and only needed cleaning and some minimal carving to get it to where it is today. I studied this tree for three years after collecting it before its first styling in 1998.
