The joy for me is working on trees with people and with the tree. Its health being the most important factor in all choices of work. This is a quote taken from Kris' bio and during his demo, he repeatedly emphasized this idea.

What is "Black Dodge Bonsai (DBD)?" Black Dodge Bonsai is a two man, and one truck, John Rough, Kris Springer and a famous Black Dodge. This is a reoccurring theme

and the name of his garden and Kris wore a shirt and shared a shirt with Ted Matson that had a different Black Dodge truck. His truck and friends led him to become one of the best sources for Yamamori in the northeast. For Kris collecting trees is almost as amazing as taking raw stock and creating cool, wild looking trees with motion, emotion and maybe a bit of whimsy.



Joe couldn't find a Yamamori but got the next best thing.













One of the things Kris said was you need to work with the tree and not against it, the same as with yamadori collected trees. He has a more difficult time growing trees in his climate than we do. He works in a three-year cycle, first year wire, second year shape, and third year repot. In LA we can do all these things in one year. Follow the rules, then throw them out.

What does the tree have to offer? Clean up tree to show elements. Show/create taper to show movement. Trees always sow interest in motion. Healing wounds in trees, use Vaseline can increase healing twice as fast. Preparation H ointment can help heal a tree faster, but it must be a tree thate produce resin.
