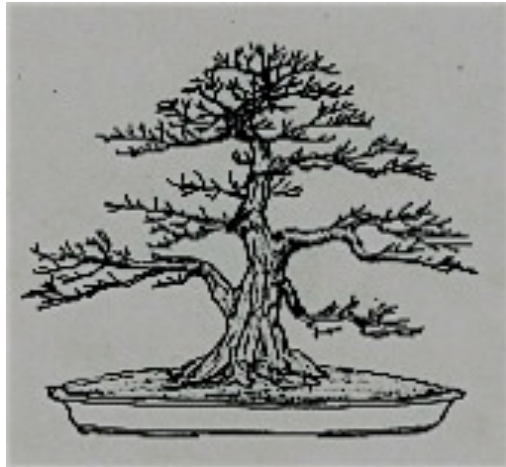

*Master Artist Lindsay Shiba* began learning bonsai in 1970 from his father, Katsumi Shiba (who had in turn learned from John Naka). Later he continued his formal training under Khan Komai, who introduced Lindsay to the love of deciduous trees, accent plantings, and displaying bonsai in a formal setting. Harry Hirao is Lindsay's present mentor-teacher. During the last few years he has been assisting Ben Oki with demos and workshops. His Bachelor of Science degree in Ornamental Horticulture and minor in Irrigation from California State Polytechnic University, Pomona, has gone "hand-in-hand" with his interests in bonsai and managing the family nursery in Upland, California.



Lindsay teaches beginning through advanced workshop courses in bonsai at their nursery, Mt. Fuji Garden Center. When available, he presents many demonstrations and workshops in California and out of state. He is currently a show chairman of Baikeon Bonsai Kenkyukai, Past-President of California Bonsai Society, and member of Nampukai .



*Student Joe Galgoul* is a 36 year resident of and employee with the City of Pasadena. His love of the art of Bonsai began three years ago when he attended his first show at The Huntington Library. He instantly attached himself to this beautiful art and began taking classes under the tutelage of Master Lindsay Shiba. He has become a serious student of the art and is currently a member of several professional Bonsai clubs including Baikeon Bonsai Kenkyukai , Kofu Kai Bonsai Club and the Descanso Bonsai Association. He is also a member of the Golden State Bonsai Federation Collection at the Huntington Library where he actively fund raises for the group. He looks for every opportunity to learn and grow in what has now become his serious passion and hobby. He is honored and excited to share his trees with you.

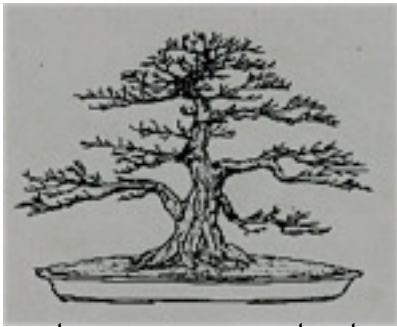
